Jesus Is Born

The stories about Jesus are found in the Bible. In the Bible God speaks to us. In the Old Testament of the Bible there are many prophecies about Jesus. These prophecies begin with God speaking to Adam and Eve, our first parents. Adam and Eve disobey God. This disobedience was the first sin. Then God, because of his love and mercy, promises to send them and all people a Savior. Throughout the Old Testament more prophesies about the coming Savior are given.

Finally, Jesus, the Savior, is born. This booklet tells you about the birth of Jesus. It is a story about God's love for you. God's love causes Him to send His only Son to be your Savior. It is the story of God's messengers, the angels. These angels speak to Mary, the mother of Jesus, and to Joseph about Jesus' birth. The angels also announce to some shepherds the joyful message that a Savior is born. As you read this story, your heart will be filled with joy like that of the shepherds.

As a young man, Jesus shows He is the Son of God by His preaching and His miracles. Later the people of His nation, Israel, become angry with Jesus. They put Him to death. Jesus, however, rises from the dead. He can do this because He is the Son of God. Now He lives in heaven. You can read about this in the Bible. Other booklets, like this one, also tell you about Jesus as the Son of God, His death, and His rising from the dead and return to heaven.

You will want to read more about Jesus. He is your Savior from sin, from the fear of death, and from destruction in hell forever. He is the Savior who makes it possible for you to go to heaven. There you will live with God forever.
